### WORKING DOG COMPETITION

*\*\*Copies of the AKC Certificates or AKC Awards Record can be used for verification purposes*

Working Dog- Competition (WD-C) = 5 points in 2 or more venue with one venue being 3 points or more.

Working Dog Excellent (WDX-C) = 7 points in 2 or more venues with one venue being 3 points or more.

Comment: In the Agility venue, either count standard class or jumpers, not both. For all venues, only highest title can be counted

### WORKING DOG-SERVICE (WD-S) or WORKING DOG-HERDING (WD-H)

#### Working Dog-Service (WD-S)

Certified Assistance Dog who has been in service for one year including, but not limited to: Working Guide, Hearing, Service Rescue or Police Dog. Submit a certification from the service organization and the owner/handler or a video of dog/handler/owner working that will be reviewed by a minimum of 2 members of the Merit Committee for approval if the dog/bitch is self-trained by his owner/handler and not trained through a service organization. Acceptable service organizations include, but are not limited to: Guide Dogs for the Blind, Seeing Eye, Canine Companions for Independence, US Police Canine Association, Paws for a Cause and other approved incorporated groups/individuals or chartered public agencies with written standards. A member may request that an organization and/or individual submit guidelines to the Merit Committee for approval.

#### Working Dog – Herd (WD-H)

Option 1: Successfully complete an AKC Herding Intermediate title on any stock or course

Option 2: Working Herd Dog who does actual herding work on a regular basis.

Submit a video of the dog's daily herding activities and also a description in writing with any unusual or special activities that occurred when in service. The video will be reviewed by a minimum of 2 members of the Merit Committee for approval

#### To Enter Working Dog Sweeps

To qualify to enter Working Dog Sweeps at the BSCA National Specialty, you must have met all the requirements before December 31 of the previous year. Your form and AKC report must have been turned in before February 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year, and you must have received confirmation from the Merit Committee that you have, in fact, qualified for that Award. You will receive your Certificate and Engraved Frame at the Banquet. Congratulations!
